The Capital Planning Committee is responsible for creating a Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) for the Town of Newbury. The Town of Newbury's present debt burden exceeds \$22 million and the town is facing several critical decisions on major capital projects. These projects include the construction of a new police station, town hall and senior center. In addition, the CIP would detail planned expenditures for road improvements, equipment purchases and other significant items.
